Jessica Lynn Leeper is a second year DPhil Candidate in History at the University of Oxford, focusing on American women's contributions and social experiences in European diplomatic court settings (1780-1820). She is primarily interested in the U.S. presidential Adams family, 18th century print culture, and transatlantic cosmopolitan connections. She holds an undergraduate MA in History from the University of Edinburgh, and an MA in 18th Century Studies from the University of York. She has five years of experience in academic editing and publishing, and two years of curatorial work experience in museums.

Itamar Toussia Cohen is a DPhil Candidate in History at the University of Oxford, whose research focuses on the port of Aden under British rule (1839-1967) looking at the port as a site of global-imperial infrastructure preceding post-imperial sites of the offshore economy, undergirded by private merchant capital, namely that of the port's Parsi (Indian-Zoroastrian) community.

Michael Heimos is pursuing a DPhil in History at the University of Oxford and his research project centers on the Protestant re-thinking and parochial reception of the Book of Ecclesiastes in late-Elizabethan England. Prior to matriculating at Oxford, he practiced law from 1995 to 2015 and specialized in cross-border tax and inheritance matters, primarily in crafting succession plans for multi-national estates. Mike's long-term research interests range widely across the historical topography of late medieval & early modern Britain and colonial North America.

Daniel Poole is a historian and member of Uncomfortable Oxford whose research includes the Malayan Emergency, the Information Research Department (IRD), and the biographies of British socialists. Recently he finished the first complete history of the 1952 British-Malayan Headhunting Scandal. In 2022 he begun research on the biography of Charlie Hutchison, a veteran of both Dunkirk and Cable Street, liberator of Bergen-Belsen, and the only known black-British man to fight fascism in Spain.
